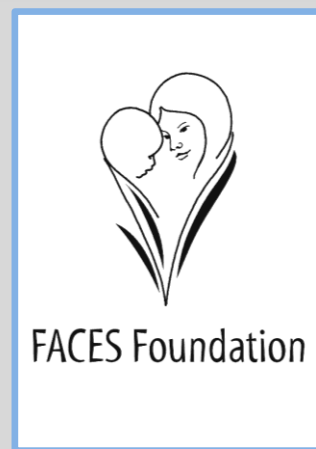
As we reflect on 2025, the FACES family feels gratitude and awe for what compassion, skill, and generosity can accomplish.

PROGRAMMING



SURGICAL CAMPAIGN – LAMBAYEQUE, PERU JANUARY 2025

Together with the medical community of Northern Peru, the FACES team offered comprehensive cleft care to families who are geographically and financially isolated from specialized healthcare. 2025 marked the 15th year of partnership with Hospital Belén of Lambayeque.

Surgery

During 5 operating days, the team provided surgeries for **41 patients**, at no cost to them or their families.

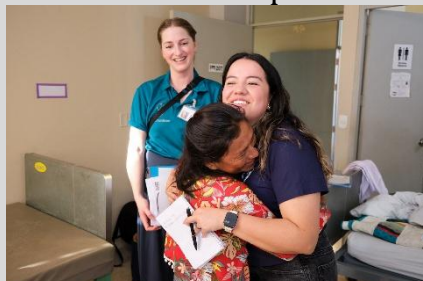
The surgeons performed 12 lip repairs, 15 primary palate repairs, 8 palate revisions, 5 bone grafts, and 2 frenulectomies.



Speech Therapy

Throughout the week, the Speech Language Pathologists offered **100** evaluations and **39** speech therapy sessions.

They also collaborated with the surgeons and scoped 11 surgical candidates and discussed post-op education with 28 sets of parents.



Scar Treatment

This is the 3rd year that FACES has offered microneedling treatments to older patients to reduce appearance of scars from past surgeries.

In 2025, **18 patients** received treatments with advanced esthetician Natalie Williams.

Speech Therapy Program

Our speech therapy program continues to grow each year.

In 2025, FACES completed a record 405 sessions – our most impactful year since our program began!

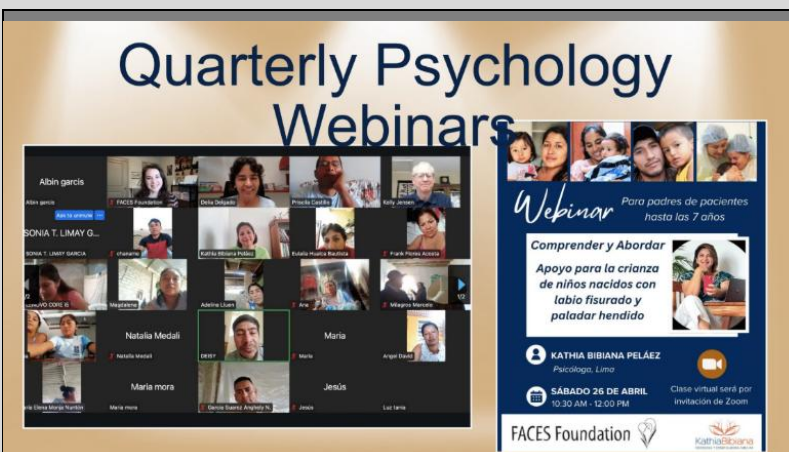
Patients come to us from rural areas across different communities across Northern Peru, carefully selected following their surgeries to ensure they receive the support they need.

This reflects the dedication and hard work of our entire team. Being part of each child's progress is rewarding, and their transformations inspire our team every day.



Psychological Accompaniment

A new offering for patients & families



Kathia Bibiana Peláez, educator and family therapist in Lima, learned of the FACES campaign through family members who work at the Hospital in Lambayeque. Touched by the impact of the work, she volunteered to help.

With Ms. Peláez's expertise, FACES has hosted three webinars to aid parents of children who have received cleft

surgeries, and to aid adolescents who have been patients themselves. Indeed, all of us benefit from a listening ear and a professional's perspective.

Highlights

FACES visits Tabaconas - San Ignacio, Cajamarca



In February, Angela Kelly, Delia Delgado, Carlos Disner, and Kelly Jensen traveled to Tabaconas to visit patients and the local government officials who have agreed to provide the funding for patient travel and lodging necessary for the annual FACES surgical campaign.

The District of Tabaconas consists of 8 settlements and 20+ house groupings scattered for over 20 miles along the Tabaconas river valley. Nilton Garcia, Coordinator for People with Disabilities, covers an extensive territory in his important work and is in regular communication with FACES staff in Peru. Patients have enjoyed overwhelmingly positive surgical results and FACES is well known in the region.

The mayor received the FACES team with a formal meeting and recognitions, including signing of the formal municipality – FACES Foundation agreement which was formalized in 2025.



People First, *Las Leonas*

The local Lions clubs are major partners in the surgical campaigns. The volunteers of the "Ciudad Evocadora" club ensure the patients' families receive proper instruction prior to the campaign.

They also distribute breakfast, lunch and dinner for the family members staying at the hospital.

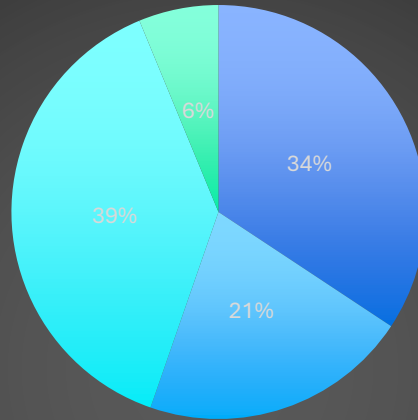

It was a joy to gather in the spirit of friendship and giving on October 11th. Together, we raised \$98,475.65 for the Surgical Campaign in Peru!

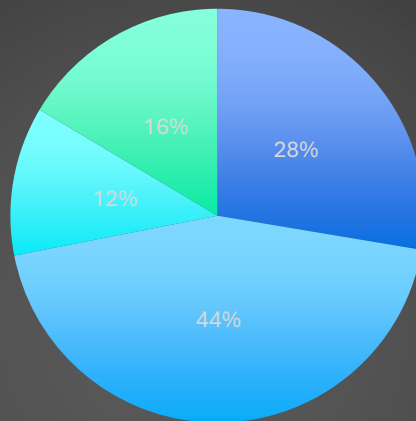
